Our events bring together participants from across the Research in Practice network to learn from experts and share knowledge with peers.



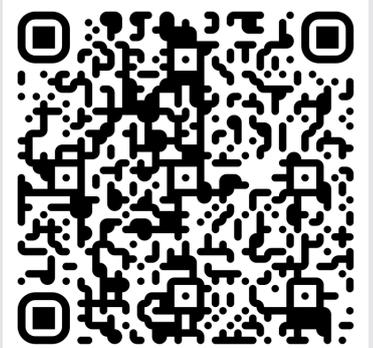
